We are grateful to the Town Council for a 'start up' grant which funded the initial open meeting to which all members of the community were invited. About twenty people attended and lots of new ideas were suggested. Follow up meetings are planned where priorities will be decided and a plan drawn up.

Transport, Town Centre, Traffic and Parking, Community Safety and Crime Group

This group has had a quiet year and is looking for more projects.

Heritage Group

This group has continued to function and is grateful to the TC for their generous grant towards the funds for Heritage Day. Last year's successful Heritage day was on the theme of Books with a focus on literary anniversaries. Highlights included a performance by Howden and District U3A Ukulele group, a Punch and Judy show, mobile scooter trials, a craft activity, Sam's Safaris, a treasure hunt, Anna's Academy of Dance, and visits to the Brewery and Cowick Hall. This year's Heritage Day will be on 9 September with a theme of Circus.

Summary of Accounts to year end 28 February 2017.

Income

SCT has been well supported with grants from the Town Council: £500 towards the cost of Heritage Day, £400 as a start up grant for Snaith and Cowick Growing Together, and £80 for website hosting. Additionally there is £999.20 in the Community Account, Business money manager £0.02, and £35 from the AGM 2016 raffle.

Expenditure

Expenditure shows AGM raffle prize £20.00, Heritage Day 2016 £562.85, website costs 2017 £71.68, with a sub total of £654.71. Additionally there is cash in bank as follows: Community account £1359.49 and Business money manager £0.02.
